## FLIGHT

Flight	<p><b>As historians we are learning to:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Place events and artefacts in order on a timeline.</li> <li>Describe significant people from the past</li> <li>Observe or handle evidence to ask questions and find answers to questions about the past.</li> <li>Ask questions such as: What was it like for people? What happened? How long ago?</li> </ul> <p>Extension:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Identify some of the different ways the past has been represented.</li> <li>Recognise that there are reasons why people in the past acted as they did.</li> </ul>
Learning Thread Focus	<p>Comparison – Comparing explorers and modes of travel</p> <p>Chronology – Order events in the development of flight on a timeline.</p> <p>Lower KS2 – Comparing life in Ancient Egypt with early life in the UK.</p>

Cross Curricular Links and wider influences	<p><b>Key Text-</b> After the storm Looking at the different and ingenious ways the treehouse has been developed. What links can we draw with the treehouse invention and the invention of the aeroplane?</p> <p>The Darkest Dark A look into how Chris Hadfield overcame his fear of the dark to reach his goals. What fears do we have that stop us from reaching our goals?</p> <p><b>Art</b> – Michelangelo inventions/Wright Brothers’ aeroplane Drawing: Study inventors designs, draw own design of flying machine.</p> <p><b>DT</b> – Michelangelo inventions/Wright Brothers aeroplane Sculpture: Measure to the nearest centimetre, use a range of tools, demonstrate a range of cutting and shaping skills and joining techniques.</p>
